

Amending a Declaration Declaring Land Taken for Road and the Use, Convenience, or Enjoyment of a Road in Block III, Clyde Survey District, Wairoa County

PURSUANT to section 330A of the Public Works Act 1928, the Minister of Works and Development hereby amends the declaration dated the 18th day of September 1978 published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 86, 12 October 1978, at p. 2765, declaring land taken for road, and the use, convenience, or enjoyment of a road in Block III, Clyde Survey District, Wairoa County, pursuant to section 32 of the Public Works Act 1928, by omitting the First Schedule and substituting the following.
