## MAUNGATUROTO SEWERAGE LOAN 1978 \$302,000

The following resolution was passed at a meeting of the Otamatea County Council held on the 12th day of July 1979.

"That for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$302,000 authorised to be raised by the Otamatea County Council under the Local Authority Loans Act 1956 for the purpose of providing sewage treatment and disposal facilities for the Maungaturoto Sewerage Scheme; the said Otamatea County Council hereby makes a special rate of 2.732 cents in the dollar upon the rateable value, based on the land value of all rateable property in the Maungaturoto Urban Drainage Area; and that the special rate shall be an annual—recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 30 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

NOTICE is hereby given that the Christchurch City Council, proposes under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928 and its amendments, to take for public road the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land to be used for road pursuant to the provisions of section 319 of the Local Government Amendment Act 1973.
