1. **Title**—This notice may be cited as the Local Government (Allowances for Mayor and Deputy Mayor of Borough of Kapiti) Notice 1979.

2. **Commencement and expiry**—(1) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

(2) This notice shall continue in force until the close of the 11th day of October 1980 and shall then expire.

3. **Annual allowance to Mayor and Deputy Mayor**—Notwithstanding the provisions of clauses 3 (1) and 4 of the Local Government (Remuneration and Allowances) Notice 1978\*, the annual allowances payable by the Kapiti Borough Council to the Mayor and Deputy Mayor of that Borough may,—

4. **Saving**—Except as provided in clause 3 of this notice nothing in this notice shall affect the application of the Local Government (Remuneration and Allowances) Notice 1978.
