Revoking a Proclamation Declaring an Area in the Hawera Acclimatisation District, Taranaki Land District, to be a Wildlife Refuge

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, The Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the proclamation dated the 16th day of August 1956*, declaring an area of land in the Hawera Acclimatisation District, Taranaki Land District, to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953, in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

PART Section 14, Block II, Hawera Survey District: area, 37 acres, 3 roods, 2.4 perches, more or less. All certificate of title, Volume 195, folio 70 (Taranaki Registry); as the same is more particularly delineated on plan numbered I.A. 52/193, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
