

along the boundary, the eastern and southern boundaries of Tokaanu B2M5 and the production of the said southern boundary to the western side of a roadway, along that side, the eastern and northern boundaries of Tokaanu B2M8, the eastern boundary of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 9B, the southern side of No. 41 State Highway, the western and southern boundaries of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 9C, the eastern and northern boundaries of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 8A and the northern boundaries of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 8B and 7 to the north-western corner of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 7; thence north-easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of Waihi-Kahakaharoa 1F and along the production of that line to the middle of the Waihi Stream; thence, generally, easterly down the middle of the Waihi Stream and along the, generally, southern shore of Lake Taupo to the point of commencement.

*The Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977,  
Amendment No. 2*

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1967, the Milk Prices Authority hereby gives the following notice:

**NOTICE**

1. This notice may be cited as the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 2.

(ii) This notice shall come into force with effect from the 1st day of July 1978.

(iii) This notice is given after consultation with the Minister of Agriculture.

(iv) This notice further amends the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal notice"), as varied by the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 1†.

2. The principal notice is hereby varied by revoking the Schedule thereto and replacing the same with the following Schedule:

5. Storing by refrigeration in vendor's depot .....	0.49
6. Storing by refrigeration in community depot .....	0.74
