Post Office Savings Bank Term Deposit Account Interest Notice 1979

THE rate of interest applicable to money held in Post Office Savings Bank Term Deposit accounts shall be as set out in the Schedule below. This notice shall come into force on the 27th day of August 1979.

SCHEDULE

1. The maximum rate of interest to be payable on money deposited in a Term Deposit account for any period of deposit commencing on or after the commencement of this notice shall be:

2. The rate of interest payable on money withdrawn from term deposit accounts before the expiration of the period of deposit shall be:

(1) Under 30 days-nil.

(2) Thirty days but less than 3 years: the rate provided in clause 1 as appropriate to the nearest completed term of investment less 2 percent per annum, except that where money is withdrawn because of the death of the depositor the full rate appropriate to the nearest completed term of investment will be payable.

3. Explanatory Note

Clause 1 fixes the rate of interest payable on different amounts of money held in term deposit accounts for particular periods of deposit. Clause 2 fixes the rate of interest payable on money withdrawn from term deposit accounts before the expiration of the specified period of deposit.
