PURSUANT to the Forests and Rural Fires Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Marlborough North Rural Fire District Order 1979.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after its notification in the New Zealand Gazette.
2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires the "Act" means the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977, "District" means the Marlborough North Rural Fire District.

PART I-CONSTITUTION OF THE MARLBOROUGH NORTH RURAL FIRE DISTRICT

3. The area specified in the Schedule to this order is hereby constituted and declared to be a rural fire district to be known as the Marlborough North Rural Fire District.

4. The trees and other plants on the land, described in the Schedule to this order, are hereby specified as the property for the protection for which the district is constituted

5. The period between the 1st day of October in any 1 year and the 30th day of September in the following year (both days inclusive) is hereby declared to be a restricted fire season in the district

6. The Marlborough North Rural Fire District shall be administered for the purposes of the said Act by a committee administered for the purposes of the said Act by a commutee consisting of nine members representing the New Zealand Forest Service, Marlborough Sounds Maritime Park Board, Marlborough County Council, Marlborough Forest Owners Association, Federated Farmers of New Zealand (this repre-sentative shall have territorial interests in the Marlborough North Rural Fire District), New Zealand Fire Services Com-ministion Marlborough Cotchment Board and a member of mission, Marlborough Catchment Board, and a member of the Residents and Ratepayers Associations within the Marlborough North Rural Fire District.

NELSON CONSERVANCY-MARLBOROUGH COUNTY MARLBOROUGH NORTH RURAL FIRE DISTRICT
