Authorising the Reclamation of Land-Otago Harbour

KEITH HOLYOAKE, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of December 1979

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 175 (3) of the Harbours Act 1950, and subject to sections 176 to 182 of the Act, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Otago Harbour Board to reclaim 1.488 hectares of land, more or less, from the bed of the Otago Harbour at Dunedin, subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereto. The land to be reclaimed is shown on plan M.D.(S) 395 (S.O. 19373) deposited in the regional office of the Ministry of Transport at Christchurch.

SCHEDULE

1. No reclamation authorised by this Order in Council may be commenced until such time as the harbour board has constructed a bund wall around the area of land which it is proposed to reclaim.
