The Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 5

PURSUANT to the Milk Act 1967, the Milk Prices Authority hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

1. (i) This notice may be cited as the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 5.

(ii) This notice shall come into force with effect from the 1st day of May 1980.

(iii) This notice is given after consultation with the Minister of Agriculture.

(iv) This notice further amends the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977* (hereinafter referred to as "the principle notice"), as varied by the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 1†, the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 2‡, the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 3§, and the Milk Treatment Allowances Notice 1977, Amendment No. 4¶.

2. The principal notice is hereby further varied by revoking the Schedule thereto and replacing the same with the following Schedule:
