		Romper Suits— A two piece set comprising of an unattached sleeved or sleeveless top and pants. The pants to have a maximum crutch waist measurement of 51 cm and the top a maximum chest measurement of 56 cm						
		Shawls—Babies Woven— Rectangular or circular baby wrap						
		Skirts with Bodice Type Tops— *51 cm length						
		Skirts with Straps Attached to Waistband— Loose flowing garment attached at waist 31 cm from top of waistband to lowest point of hem						
		Sleeping Bags—Babies— With or without hood 76 cm from highest point of shoulder to bottom at back when laid flat						
		Snow or Ski Suits—With or Without Hood or Feet— Heavy one or two piece outer garment, woven, suited for wear outdoors during cold weather. Does not include garments with or without print or embroidered trim, designed primarily for use as sleep suits 76 cm from mid-shoulder to ankle						
		Swimsuits and Bathing Trunks— One or two piece swimwear for boys and girls 41 cm waist-crutch-waist						
		Trousers—Short— Short legged, legless or romper type trousers, suitable for outerwear 51 cm waist-crutch-waist						
		Trousers—Full Length— Two legged outer garment reaching from waist to ankles 56 cm side waist to bottom of hem						
		(Note: Where leg terminates in an elasticised ankle band or a turn-up cuff, measurement along outside of leg to bottom of elastic band or to bottom of cuff when turned down, is not to exceed 61 cm)
