NAFTA: Schedule A Access—Third Review List

In the 3 June 1980 edition of the *Manufacturer*, the New Zealand Manufacturers Federation published a further list of goods included on Schedule A of NAFTA which are subject to import licensing control. Consideration is being given to making these goods licence on demand when of Australian origin.
