PURSUANT to the Waikato Valley Authority Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order:

1. Waikato Valley Authority Order—(1) This order shall be known as the Waikato Valley Authority Order 1980. (2) This order shall come into force the day after the date of notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Constitution of the Authority—The Waikato Valley Authority shall consist of 14 elective members with representation of such elective members as follows:
