hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited
as the Harbour Boards (Chairman's Allowance) Order 1980.

2. **Maximum allowance to Chairman of Harbour Board**—
The maximum rate of annual allowance that pursuant to
section 36 (1) of the Harbours Act 1950 may be paid to
the Chairman of any Harbour Board specified in the first
column of the Schedule to this order is hereby altered to
the rate specified opposite the name or description of that
Board in the second column of that Schedule.
