## A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 265 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, I, The Right Honourable Sir Keith Jacka Holyoake, the Governor-General of New Zealand, being satisfied that the land described in the Schedule hereto has been vested in the Crown, hereby declare the said land to be Crown land subject to the Land Act 1948.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 28th day of January 1980

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. B. E. TALBOYS PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## O R D E R

1. (1) This order may be cited as the union of Stratford County and Whangamomona Pest Destruction Districts Order 1980.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Stratford County Pest Destruction District (which was constituted pursuant to section 13A, Rabbits Act 1955, on the 18th day of November 1964) and the Whangamomona Pest Destruction District (which was constituted by Order in Council on the 20th day of March 1972), are hereby declared united to form one district to be called the Stratford County Pest Destruction District, the boundaries of which shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The basis on which the board for the said District shall first levy its general rate shall be a graduated scale according to a classification of the land occupied by the ratepayer.

## BOUNDARIES OF THE STRATFORD COUNTY PEST DESTRUCTION DISTRICT
