*Fixing a Levy on Fish (No. 2339, Ag. 9/2/1/6)*

PURSUANT to the New Zealand Fishing Industry Board Act 1963, and regulation 5 (1) (a) of the Fish Levy Regulations 1976 as amended by regulation 3 of the Fish Levy Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, notice is hereby given by the New Zealand Fishing Industry Board that:

(a) From and after the 1st day of April 1980 every wholesaler shall pay to the Board a fish levy on all fish except rock lobster taken or purchased by him (otherwise than from another wholesaler) at a rate of 0.9 percent of the primary price of those fish, and

(b) From and after the 1st day of April 1980 every wholesaler shall pay to the Board a fish levy on rock lobster taken or purchased by him (otherwise than from another wholesaler) at a rate of 0.8 percent of the primary price of those rock lobster.

(c) Notice published in *New Zealand Gazette*, 24 February 1977, No. 19, p. 408, is consequently revoked.

Expressions used in this notice have the same meanings as in the Fish Levy Regulations 1976.
