- 4. Vesting of Land Formerly Vested in the Corporation of the District of Southland County—The Corporation of the district of Winton Borough shall, in respect of the areas described in the Schedule to this order, have vested in it, subject to all existing encumbrances, all land situated in those areas that were previously vested in the Corporation of the District of Southland County.
- 5. Mayor and Principal Officer—The mayor and principal officer of the Winton Borough Council shall exercise the duties, powers, and functions of the chairman and principal officer of the Southland County Council in respect of the areas described in the Schedule to this order.
- 6. Creditors—Subject to section 37F of the Local Government Act 1974, the rights or interests of creditors of any districts affected by the order shall not be affected.
- 7. Rating—The system of rating in the areas described in the Schedule to this order shall continue to be the land value system.
