Commerce Act 1975

1. By letter dated 25 March 1980 the Minister of Trade and I by letter dated 25 March 1980 the Minister of Irade and Industry has required the Commerce Commission to inquire, pursuant to section 82 (7) of the Act, and report to him on the desirability of removing from the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1977 the wholesale and retail margins applied to-

"Butter, manufactured in New Zealand, except when sold-

(a) Ex factory; or

(b) In portions not exceeding 30g."

(Government has recently removed butter prices at the manufacturing level from Positive List control.) A copy of the full text of the Minister's letter is available on application to the Commission.

2. The Minister has asked that the report of the Commission cover in particular:

- (a) whether price control in terms of section 82 of the Act should be continued; or
- (b) whether price restraint in terms of section 83 would be warranted if price control were removed; or
- (c) such other recommendations as the Commission thinks fit.

3. The Minister has asked that the report be sent to him by 30 September 1980 but that he would be willing to extend that date should the need arise.

4. As a first step, the Commission requests any persons or organisations who may wish to apply to be a party to the inquiry, in terms of section 14, to notify the Executive Officer of the Commission of this in writing by 4 p.m., Thursday, 1 May 1980. This notification to give reasons in support of the application and to indicate whether the applicant supports or is opposed to the removal of price control
