

and proceeding generally south-easterly and north-easterly along the Kauaeranga River to its intersection with No. 25 State Highway, along No. 25 State Highway to Kopu, along No. 26 State Highway to Paeroa, along No. 2 State Highway to Waihi, along No. 25 State Highway to its intersection with Whiritoa Creek, and along Whiritoa Creek to the coastline.

(e) All that land in Taranaki Land District, lying within 7 kilometres of the boundary of Mount Egmont National Park.

(f) All outlying islands and Dependencies of New Zealand except Kaikoura Island and D'Urville Island.
