

8. All reasonable expenses of or incidental to preparing, perusing and advertising the 'scheme' shall be paid out of and be a charge upon the fund.

The scheme has been prepared because the purpose for which the original Trust fund was established has now become superfluous and is so restrictive as to be useless.
