NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND FOR QUARRYING PURPOSES

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cook County Council acting under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1928, proposes to take the land described in the Schedule hereto for quarrying

purposes.
