- 4. Prices for milk supplied by approved associations—Subject to section 25 (5) of the Act, the price at which any quantity of milk supplied during any period specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this notice is sold—
  - (a) By any approved association to another approved association; or
  - (b) Where the operator of a treatment station is not acting in the capacity of a vendor, by any approved associa-tion to that operator,—

shall be calculated at the rate specified in the second column of that schedule opposite the reference to that period in the first column of that schedule.

- 5. Allowances—There shall be payable to milk producers or, as the case may be, approved associations, in respect of each service specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this notice provided after the 31st day of August 1979 an allowance calculated at the rate specified in the second column of that schedule opposite the reference to that service.
- 6. Revocations—The following notices are hereby consequentially revoked:
