DZ 5813 Underwater swimming equipment.

This draft specifies requirements for underwater swimming equipment, including self-contained underwater breathing apparatus which has been designed to be used with compressed air in cylinders carried by the wearer and not with gas mixtures or oxygen.

It is also intended as a guide for underwater swimmers.

It contains recommendations on the equipment and procedures used in diving. It deals with selection, handling, use, maintenance and storage of equipment to ensure efficient operation when in use.

It is a revision of NZS 2190 and NZS 2232.
