#### 63. Coin, Bullion, Etc.

- 1. Packages containing bank notes, bullion, gold, silver, or bronze coin wil be accepted for conveyance only in accordance with the provisions of this section.
  - (a) When accompanied by a passenger-

- (i) The passenger must pay the ordinary fare and hold a ticket.
  (ii) Excess luggage rates will be charged for any quantity of such goods and luggage in excess of 50 kg for every adult ticket held.
- (b) When unaccompanied by a passenger—
  (i) Packages containing bank notes, bullion, gold, or silver will be charged double the ordinary parcels rates (section 55).
  (ii) Packages containing bronze coin will be charged ordinary parcels rates.
