Unclaimed Property—Notice of Election by the Public Trustee to Become Manager Under Part V of the Public Trust Office Act 1957

WHEREAS the Director-General of Social Welfare (hereinafter referred to as "the Director-General") has had in his possession since 1973 a diamond engagement ring which was recovered from a certain child whilst that child was under the guardianship of the Director-General, and whereas the said child subsequently admitted to the Director-General that the said ring had been stolen by him, and whereas the Director-General has made extensive enquires through the Police of New Zealand in an endeavour to locate the owner of the said ring, and whereas the said Police have been unable to either locate the owner of the said ring or to prove any offence in respect of the stealing of the said ring, and whereas the Public Trustee is satisfied that it is not known who the owner of the said ring is or where the owner is or whether the owner is alive or dead, and whereas the gross value of the said ring (as estimated by the Public Trustee) does not exceed four thousand dollars (\$4,000) and for the purposes of subsection (2) of section 80 of the Public Trust Office Act 1957, the Public Trustee is satisfied
