Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 14) 1981

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives notice as follows:

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 14) 1981.
- (b) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1981.

2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.

3. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the goods of the classes set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, included in the exemption notices shown in the Second Schedule are hereby withdrawn.

59.11.003 Ex 59.11.013	Quilted rubberised textile fabrics, other than rubberised knitted or crocheted goods Narrow woven fabrics as defined in Note 3 to Chapter 58 of the Customs Tariff and narrow fabrics (bolducs) consisting of warp without weft assembled by means of an adhesive when declared— (a) by a manufacturer for use by him only in the manufacture or repair of saddlery; (b) by an importer that they will be sold only to manufacturers for use in the manufacture and repair of saddlery.
