

## O R D E R

1. (a) This order may be cited as the Matamata Hydatids Control District Order 1981.

(b) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The areas comprising the County of Matamata, the Boroughs of Matamata and Putaruru, as from time to time constituted, are hereby declared to be united to form a hydatids control district to be called the Matamata Hydatids Control District.

3. The Matamata Hydatids Control Authority is hereby appointed the hydatids control authority for the Matamata Hydatids Control District.

4. Revocation—The Matamata Hydatids Control District Order 1974 is hereby revoked.
