MARLBOROUGH COAST WARD

ALL that area in the Marlborough Land District, Marlborough and Kaikoura Counties, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the sea coast and the middle of the Waima River, in Block XVII, Cape Campbell Survey District, and proceeding generally south-westerly along the sea coast to its intersection with the middle of the Clarence River in Block XI, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally north-westerly, northerly and north-easterly along the middle of the said river to its intersection with the production of the middle line of Boundary Stream in Block XVIII, Whernside Survey District; thence along a bearing of 23° for a distance of 2.0 kilometres and along a bearing of 41° for a distance of 2.3 kilometres to peg LX III, D.P. 705 on the boundary between D.P. 705 and Lot 2, D.P. 1340; thence northerly along the said boundary to the south-western corner of Part Lot 1, D.P. 1340; thence generally easterly along the southern boundary of the said part Lot 1 to the summit of the Lady Range; thence generally northerly along that Range to Trig Station P (Ragged Robin) in Block VIII, Whernside Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Section 5, Block VIII, Whernside Survey District (crossing 3 intersecting roads) to peg XIII, S.O. Plan 529; thence north-westerly along a right line to Trig Station WH (Whernside); thence along a bearing of 72° to the western boundary of Section 4, Block IX, Whernside Survey District; thence generally south-westerly, easterly and generally northerly along the south-eastern, southern and eastern boundaries of that Section 4 and the eastern boundary of Section 4, Block IV, Whernside Survey District, and the production of the last mentioned boundary to the middle of the Waima River; thence generally easterly along the middle of that river to the point of commencement.

KAIKOURA WARD

ALL that area in the Marlborough Land District, County of Kaikoura, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the sea coast and the left bank of the Kowhai River in Block IX, Mount Fyffe Survey District, and proceeding generally north-westerly along the left bank of the said river to a point in line with the north-western boundary of part D.P. 167 in Block I, Greenburn Survey District; thence south-westerly to the northernmost corner of part D.P. 167; thence generally north-westerly and northerly along the south-western and western boundaries of Run 225 to Trig Station T (Homestead Spur) in Block IX, Greenburn Survey District; thence generally northerly along the boundary between the areas of Crown Land, in Block IX aforesaid as shown on S.O. Plan 4580, to Trig Station Snowflake, on the summit of the Seaward Kaikoura Range in Block IX, Greenburn Survey District; thence generally north-easterly along the said summit to Trig Station R (George Spur), on the boundary between Block VII, Kaitarau Survey District, and Blocks VIII and IX, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally south-easterly along the north-easterly boundary of S.G.R. 105B and its production to the northernmost corner of S.G.R. 106 in Block XIII, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of S.G.R. 106 to its north-eastern corner; thence southerly and generally south-easterly along the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of S.G.R. 106 to its easternmost corner; thence south-westerly along the south-eastern boundary of S.G.R. 106 to the westernmost corner of part Section 3A of 2, Mangamaunu Maori Block, in Block XV, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of that Section, and its production to the sea coast; thence generally south-westerly along the sea coast to the point of commencement.

KEKERENGU WARD

ALL that area in the Marlborough Land District, Counties of Amuri, Marlborough and Kaikoura, bounded by a line commencing at a point on the middle line of the Waima River in line with the eastern boundary of Section 4, Block IV, Whernside Survey District, and proceeding generally southerly to and along that eastern boundary and the eastern boundary of Section 4, Block IX, Whernside Survey District to the south-eastern corner of the last-mentioned Section 4; thence westerly and generally north-westerly along the southern and south-western boundaries of that Section 4 to a point

bearing 72° from Trig Station WH (Whernside) in Block VIII, Whernside Survey District; thence along a bearing of 252° to that Trig Station; thence south-easterly along a right line to peg XIII, S.O. Plan 529 on the south-western boundary of Section 5, Block VIII, Whernside Survey District; thence generally south-easterly along that south-western boundary (crossing three intersecting roads) to Trig Station P (Ragged Robin) in Block VIII, Whernside Survey District; thence generally southerly along the summit of the Lady Range to the southern boundary of Part Lot 1, D.P. 1340, in Block XIV, Whernside Survey District; thence generally westerly along that southern boundary to the south-western corner of the said Lot 1; thence southerly along the boundary between D.P. 705 and Lot 2, D.P. 1340, to peg LXIII D.P. 705; thence along a bearing of 221° for a distance of 2.3 kilometres and along a bearing of 203° for a distance of 2.0 kilometres to the intersection of the middle line of the Clarence River and the production of the middle line of Boundary Stream, in Block XVIII, Whernside Survey District; thence due west to the right bank of the Clarence River; thence generally north-westerly and south-westerly along the said right bank to the right bank of Jam Stream in Block I, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally southerly along the last-mentioned right bank to a point in line with the south-western boundary of part Section 3, Block IV, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally south-easterly to and along the south-western boundaries of part Section 3, Block IV and Part 3, Block VIII, Puhī Puhī Survey District, to Trig Station R (George Spur) on the summit of the Seaward Kaikoura Range; thence generally south-westerly along the summit of the said Range to Palmer Saddle in Block XI, Acheron Survey District; thence generally westerly and south-westerly along the summit of the Amuri Range to the watershed between the Mason and Towy Rivers; thence generally south-easterly along that watershed to an unnamed peak 1240 metres (4070 feet) in height; thence along a bearing of 204° to the intersection of the middle of the Mason River and the southern boundary of Run 208 (Cloudy Range); thence generally westerly and north-easterly along the southern and north-western boundaries of Run 208 to the southern boundary of the Crown Land lying between the said Run 208 and the Clarence River in Block XXI, Acheron Survey District; thence due north to the left bank of the Clarence River; thence generally north-easterly along the left bank of the Clarence River to the right bank of the Spray Stream, in Block XI, Tone Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the said right bank and the western boundary of part Run 119 to the south-eastern boundary of part Run 216; thence generally north-easterly along that boundary to the south-western boundary of Section 1, Block IX, Tapuaenuku Survey District; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the Inland Kaikoura Range to a point bearing 240° from a peak on the Inland Kaikoura Range known as Pinnacle; thence along a bearing of 60° for a distance of approximately 4.32 kilometres to Pinnacle; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the said range to and continuing north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of part Run 207 to the southern boundary of Run 121A; thence generally easterly along the southern boundary of Run 121A and the southern boundary of Run 209 to the western boundary of the Crown Land lying between the said Run 209 and the Swale River, and continuing easterly to and along the said boundary of Run 209 to the westernmost corner of D.P. 710; thence easterly along the northern boundary of D.P. 710 to the north-eastern corner of the said D.P. 710; thence south-easterly, north-easterly and northerly along the south-western, south-eastern, and eastern boundaries of Part Lot 6, D.P. 346 and the production of the last mentioned boundary to the right bank of the Waima River; thence due north to the middle of the said river; thence generally easterly along the middle of that river to the point of commencement.

OHAU WARD

ALL that area in the Marlborough Land District, County of Kaikoura, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the sea coast and the middle of the Clarence River in Block IX, Puhī Puhī Survey District, and proceeding generally north-westerly, northerly and north-easterly along the middle of the said river to its intersection with the production of the middle line of Boundary Stream in Block XVIII, Whernside Survey District; thence due west to the right bank of the Clarence River; thence generally north-westerly and south-westerly along the said right bank to the right bank of Jam Stream, in Block I, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally southerly along the last mentioned right bank to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Part Section 3, Block IV, Puhī Puhī Survey District; thence generally south-easterly to and along the south-western boundaries of
