*Tauranga Community College Notice 1981*

PURSUANT to section 69 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

1. (1) This notice shall be cited as the Tauranga Community College Notice 1981.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. There shall be a board of governors to be known as the Tauranga Community College Council which shall control the Tauranga Community College.

3. The Tauranga Community College Council shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Tauranga City Council.
- (b) One member appointed by the Mount Maunganui Borough Council.
- (c) Two members appointed by the Tauranga County Council to represent the interests of eastern country areas and western country areas respectively.
- (d) One member elected by the governing bodies of the secondary schools listed in the first Schedule to this notice.
- (e) One member appointed by the Bay of Plenty Province Incorporation of Federated Farmers of New Zealand.
- (f) One member appointed by the Tauranga Moana District Maori Council.
- (g) One member appointed by the Bay of Plenty Fruit-growers Association.
- (h) One member appointed by the council of the University of Waikato.
- (i) One member who shall be resident in the area served by the college, appointed by the National Council of Women of New Zealand Incorporated.
- (j) One member who shall be resident in the district served by the college appointed by the Bay of Plenty Trades Council.
- (k) One member elected by the associations of employers in local industries.
- (l) One member who shall be the principal of the Tauranga Community College.
- (m) One member who shall represent the staff of the Tauranga Community College and who shall be
