(2) To carry on throughout New Zealand and elsewhere all or any of the activities aforementioned and to trade in all classes of goods, wares and commodities of every description.

4. *Principal Place of Business:* The Registered Office of the General Partner is at 16 St. Marks Road, Remuera.
