

*The Water Recreation (Paraparaumu Beach) Notice 1981—
Borough of Kapiti*

I, Robin Paul Taylor, Senior Executive Officer (Harbours and Foreshores), pursuant to the Water Recreation Regulations 1979*, and in exercise of powers delegated to me pursuant to sections 8 and 9 of the Ministry of Transport Act 1968, hereby give the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Water Recreation (Paraparaumu Beach) Notice 1981.

(b) This notice shall come into force 14 days after publication in the *New Zealand Gazette* and shall remain in force until revoked by further notice in the *Gazette*.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, regulations 7 (1) a, 7 (1) b and 7 (2) of the Water Recreation Regulations 1979, shall not apply to the area as described in the First Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that area of water at Paraparaumu Beach extending 200 metres in a westerly direction from the water's edge and bounded on the sides by parallel lines 100 metres apart, the southern boundary being a point 45 metres north of the southern boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 26312, as more particularly shown marked "D" on plan M.D. 16095, deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington.

SECOND SCHEDULE

THE reserved area shall be marked as follows:

1. Two 2.5 metre transit posts with a distance of not less than 3 metres or more than 9 metres between and painted yellow, shall be erected on the land in line with each side of the reserved area, the first post being sited near high water mark.

2. On each side of the transit posts sited near high water mark there shall be fastened in line with the sides of the reserved area, suitable notices setting out the extent of the exemptions as described in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The area described in the First Schedule shall be used only by persons so authorised by the Kapiti Borough Council.

4. Notwithstanding any other provision of this notice, no person who is permitted by any such provision to propel or navigate a small craft at a speed through the water exceeding 5 knots shall do so in any manner that is likely to endanger or unduly annoy any person who is in, on, or using the water, or fishing or undertaking any recreational activity in the vicinity of the small craft.

5. All persons in charge of the vessel shall adhere to and keep the provisions of all other Acts and Regulations not specifically exempted by this notice.

The Water Recreation (Southland) Notice 1981

I, Robin Paul Taylor, Senior Executive Officer (Harbours and Foreshores), pursuant to the Water Recreation Regulations 1979*, and in exercise of powers delegated to me pursuant to sections 8 and 9 of the Ministry of Transport Act 1968, hereby give the following notice:

NOTICE

1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Water Recreation (Southland) Notice 1981.

(b) This notice shall come into force 14 days after publication in the *New Zealand Gazette* and shall remain in force until revoked by further notice in the *Gazette*.

2. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, vessels owned and operated by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries shall be exempt from regulations 7 (1) (a) and (b) and 7 (2) of the Water Recreation Regulations 1979 in the areas as described in the First Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. Waiau River—All waters from source to sea.
2. Pourakino River—All waters from source to Jacobs River Estuary.
3. Aparima River—All waters from source to Jacobs River Estuary.
4. Oreti River—All waters from source to New River Estuary.
5. Maitara River—All waters from source to Fortrose Estuary.
6. Waihopai Stream—All waters from source to New River Estuary.
7. Makarewa Stream—All waters from source to Oreti River.
8. Titiroa Stream—All waters from source to Fortrose Estuary.
9. Niagara (Waikawa) Stream—All waters from source to Waikawa Estuary.
10. Tautuku Stream—All waters from source to Tautuku Estuary.
11. Tahakopa Stream—All waters from source to Tahakopa Estuary.
12. Waikiwi Stream—All waters from source to Oreti River.
13. Waimahaka Stream—All waters from source to Titiroa Stream.
14. Fortrose Estuary—All waters of Fortrose Estuary.
15. Haldane Estuary—All waters of Haldane Estuary.
16. Waikawa Estuary—All waters of Waikawa Estuary.
17. Waituna Lagoon—All waters of Waituna Lagoon.

SECOND SCHEDULE

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this notice, no person who is permitted by any such provision to propel or navigate a small craft at a speed through the water exceeding 5 knots shall do so in any manner that is likely to endanger or unduly annoy any person who is, in, on, or using the waters or fishing, or undertaking any recreational activity in the vicinity of the small craft.

2. All persons in charge of a vessel shall adhere to and keep the provisions of all Acts and regulations not specifically exempted by this notice.

*The Insurance Companies' Deposits Act 1953—Proposed
Release of Deposits*
