It is under these circumstances that the book considers the use of military force in New Zealand, analyses the arguments surrounding the provision of troops and concludes that, beyond any reasonable doubt that there was never an attempt to govern by "moral suasion". New Zealand followed the normal nineteenth century

British pattern of territorial acquisition. The book is an essential introduction to the Maori wars

of a later date.
