PURSUANT to subsection (3) of section 23 of the Standards Act 1965, notice is hereby given that the following draft amendment is being circulated.

Number and Description of Draft

DZ 2264/A2 Amendment No. 2 to NZS 2264: 1970 Industrial safety helmets (maximum protection).

This proposed amendment would change the title of the Standard, permit the attachment of accessories to helmets during manufacture, introduce a new flammability test on the whole helmet, and amend the present headform diagram.
