Paradise duck (only in that area east and south-east of State Highways No. 3 and No. 3A from Tariki to Inglewood to Waitara to the Mokau River), 5.	
Shooting hours: 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.	
Decoy limit: No limit.

Special Conditions

1. In the Tauranga Harbour no maimai shall be erected that will impede the use of navigable channels and waters of the harbour.
2. Maimais erected in the Tauranga Harbour must be dismantled and removed at the close of the season.

Canada goose (Area A—all that area west of State Highway No. 1, excluding the floodbed of the Waitaki River to the Waitaki dam) 11 and 12 April 1981 incl., and 2 May to 25 October 1981 incl., and 6 February 1982 to 14 March 1982 incl.

(Area B—all that area that lies east of State Highway No. 1, including the floodbed of the Waitaki River) 11 and 12 April 1981 incl., and 2 May to 28 June incl.

Grey, shoveler (or spoonbill), mallard, and paradise duck, 25 in all.	Pheasant, 3.

Shooting hours: 6.30 a.m. to 7 p.m. except that during the period of 29 June 1981 to 25 October 1981 inclusive, and 6 February 1982 to 14 March 1982 inclusive. Canada goose may be hunted or killed 24 hours per day.

Decoy limit: Wainono Lagoon, maximum 25; rest of district, no limit.

Special Conditions

1. No person shall, for the purposes of hunting or killing game, build, or attempt to build, any stand, hide, shelter, maimai, mud-hole, loo, louvre, or position before 9 a.m. on 15 March 1981.

It shall be an offence to hunt or kill game from any unmoored boat on the Turakina River during the first 2 days of the open season for game only, being Saturday, 2 May 1981, and Sunday, 3 May 1981.
