PURSUANT to subclause (1) of regulation 88 of the Traffic Regulations 1976*, the Secretary for Transport hereby approves for the purposes of regulation 78 (1) (as inserted by regulation 3 (1) of the Traffic Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 2), the fitting in the seated positions specified in the Schedule hereto of the alternative types of seat belts specified in the said Schedule to the vehicles specified in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE

IN respect of any Isuzu Gemini model PF50 (with a chassis number included in the list below):

- (a) Three-point lap and diagonal seat belts, including emergency locking retractors with acceleration sensitive actuation only, of an approved type for the use of the driver and the front seat passenger nearest the left side of the vehicle (or the right side of the vehicle of a left-hand drive axle).
