A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto was taken for car sheds in connection with electric tramways and vested in the Wellington City Council by a Proclamation dated the 12th day of September 1912, and published in the *Gazette* No. 69, 1912, at p. 2540 and 2541. Now therefore pursuant to section 20 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1952, I, The Honourable Sir David Stuart Beattie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the said land is hereby set apart as from the 14th day of May 1981 for the road.
