Land Taken for Road and the Use, Convenience, or Enjoyment of a Road in Block III, Patetere North Survey District, Matamata County

DAVID BEATTIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, The Honourable Sir David Stuart Beattie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the use, convenience, or enjoyment of a road; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 21st day of May 1981.

FIRST SCHEDULE

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

Land Taken for Road

ALL that piece of land containing 1242 square metres, being part Section 84, Block III, Patetere North Survey District; as shown on plan S.O. 50374, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Hamilton, and thereon marked "1B".
