And it is hereby declared that you have liberty to report your proceedings and recommendations under this Commission from time to time if you shall judge it expedient so to do:

And, using all due diligence, you are required to report to me in writing under your hands not later than the 31st day of August 1981 your findings and opinions on the matters aforesaid, together with such recommendations as you think fit to make in respect thereof.
