1. This declaration shall come into effect upon first publication in a newspaper circulating in the infected area.

It is an offence to move plants or tree material (including branches, needles, and Christmas trees) from the infected area if such are of pine or other coniferous species and have not been treated for the purpose of needle cast disease control to the satisfaction of an authorised Forest Officer.

3. The infected area may be generally and roughly described as the land east of the portion of State Highway 1 that runs from Kamo to Hukerenui, and north of that land east of the Whangarei/Bay of Islands County boundary from Hukerenui to near Punaruku.
