The Standards Act 1965—Draft New Zealand Standard Specification Available for Comment

PURSUANT to subsection (3) of section 23 of the Standards Act 1965, notice is hereby given that the following draft New Zealand standard specification is being circulated.

Number and Title of Specification

DZ 7421 Installation of solid fuel burning and oil burning space-heaters. \$6.

This draft standard relates to the installation of factory-built space heating units burning solid fuel or oil and of the following classes:

- Room heaters (including free standing open fires with hood and flue pipe).
- Ducted heaters.
- Hot water boilers of non-pressure (vented to atmosphere) type for supplying water radiators.

The draft revises and updates NZS 7421:1972.

Number and Title of Specification

DZ 1900.10/A2 Draft amendment No. 2 to NZS 1900: Model building bylaw, Chapter 10: Non-structural external wallings.

This draft amendment will incorporate the specification for performance of windows (NZS 4211) into the model building bylaw as a means of compliance, and add to the minimum performance criteria set out in clause 8.8 of NZS 3604 so that there are now bylaw requirements.
