*Revoking as to Part a Proclamation Taking Land for the Tauranga-Te Maunga Motorway in the City of Tauranga*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1981, I, The Honourable Sir David Stuart Beattie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 5th day of June 1970, and published in the *Gazette* No. 34, of 11 June 1970, at page 1010, taking land for the Tauranga - Te Maunga motorway, in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being no longer required.

#### SCHEDULE

##### SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 8.6 perches, situated in Block XIV, Tauranga Survey District, being part Lot 15, D.P. S. 2664; as shown coloured orange on S.O. Plan 45034, lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Hamilton.
