

## NEW ZEALAND WOOL BOARD

PURSUANT to regulation 15 of the Wool Industry Regulations 1978, notice is hereby given that the Adjusted Weighted Average Sale Price for the sale held on 19 August at Dunedin, was 255.47 cents per kilogram (greasy basis).

As this price is below the Government's supplementary minimum wool price of 320 cents per kilogram (greasy basis), the specified percentage for supplementation will be 25.3 percent for all wool sold at auction and nationally for privately sold wool from and including the 19th day of August 1982 until midnight on the day before the next auction sale to be held.
