PURSUANT to section 175 (2) of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, considering that the reclamation hereby authorised:

- Will not unduly interfere with or restrict any public rights of navigation; and
- Is for the benefit of the public;
