- (i) One member elected by the school committees of Bluecliffs, Claremont, Fairview, Gleniti, Grantlea, Kingsdown, Marchwiell, Maungati, Otaio, Pareora East, Pareora West, St. Andrews, Salisbury, Seadown, Southburn, Springbook, Te Maunga, Waimataitai and Washdyke Primary Schools and Watlington Intermediate School.
