DZ 4121 Design for access by disabled persons—  
 Public buildings and facilities, \$6.

This draft standard code prescribes the functional design of public buildings and of parking facilities so that they will be accessible by people with physical disabilities. The buildings or premises are those to which the Local Government Act 331 (2) and section 25 of the Disabled Persons Community Welfare Act 1975 apply.

The draft is a revision of NZS 4121:Part 1:1971 and Part 2:1975.
