Extending the Time Within Which Commission of Inquiry into Air Traffic Control Services May Report

WHEREAS, by Order in Council made on the 19th day of July 1982*, you, the said Sir Richard Bruce Bolt, Henry Piet van Asch, and Edwin Jan Robertson were appointed to be a Commission of Inquiry to inquire into and report upon the adequacy of air traffic control services operated by the Ministry of Transport throughout New Zealand and, in particular, at the Auckland, Wellington, and Christchurch International Airports:
