# EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE dedicated area will be dedicated and used for:

1. The rearing of rare native birds.

2. (a) Experiments in establishing birds in semi-wild or wild conditions by the gradual release of birds reared in captivity.

(b) Experiments in increasing existing populations of endangered native birds in the vicinity of the establishment through the provision of permanent feeding stations and attention to nesting requirements or other aspects of habit improvement.

(c) Provision of exhibits of native birds, not necessarily rare, also in spacious enclosures to display New Zealand's native birds both to New Zealand and overseas visitors. This would also serve as an educational measure.

(d) Through the foregoing work the institution has become a centre for research and preservation of many native birds.
