Easement Granted

THE full and unrestricted right for Longworth (H.B.) Limited (together with its successors in title called the grantee) to construct and maintain over that part of the land described as "proposed easement" on the said S.O. Plan 8161 in a proper and workmanlike manner poles, wires and ancillary equipment (called the lines) for the purpose of transmitting electricity and telephone communications to the land in the said Third Schedule; together with the right for the grantee its servants, workmen and agents with any tools, machinery, vehicles or other equipment necessary on giving notice to the Crown (except in an emergency situation) to enter the land the subject of this easement and to remain there for any reasonable time for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining and renewing the lines, causing the least disruption as possible to the Crown or its successors in title and making good any damage caused to the Crown or its successors in title by the exercise of this right. The Crown may at its option and expense resite the lines ensuring that the grantee receives lines for the above-mentioned purposes and with the least disruption as possible to the grantee. If this option is exercised then the Minister shall grant a like easement to the grantee in respect of the new location.
