A textbook for students of the Maori language written in the "Tuhoē" dialect. Its subject is contemporary Maori life with those aspects of the Maori heritage which prevail in it. This book is intended for advanced fifth formers and the sixth and seventh forms.

The text has been retained in its original style in the belief that these basic studies should still be readily available without textual alteration.
