DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

- 5. Every retailer who offers or exposes for sale in any shop any Ecuadorian bananas, to which this special approval applies shall keep in a prominent position, in such proximity to the bananas to which it relates as to be obviously in relation thereto, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:
 - (a) The retail price a kilogram of the bananas.
 - (b) The word "Ecuadorian".
