NOTICE is hereby given that the Hauraki Catchment Board and Regional Water Board proposes, under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1981, to take for soil conservation and rivers control purposes the land described in the Schedule hereto. Such land is to be used for soil and water conservation works as part of the Waihou Valley Scheme. Because of the severe risk of erosion and channel instability in the area it is considered essential that the land be taken to give Board the required control of the land and the freedom to undertake all necessary works.
